Take I-75 to exit 50A Dryden Road. Turn left on Arbor Blvd (between hotel and gas station) Follow Arbor to East River Road Turn left onto East River Road. The Dayton Dog Training Club is 0.7 miles on the left in the Orbit Industrial Park. The last unit on the left just before the pond.

From the South

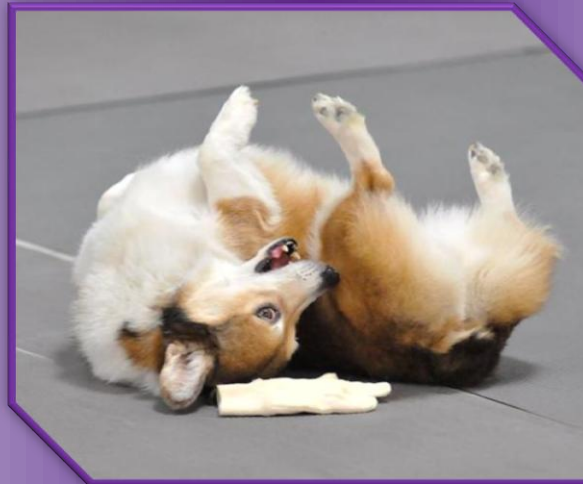
